



Safe Return 2021-22



Capacity: Students will attend at 100% capacity in the building with social distancing.



Transportation: Students will be permitted to ride the bus wearing a cloth face mask due to federal mandates. This includes transportation to and from school, athletic events, and field trips. Seats will be assigned. Siblings may sit together.



Food Service: Lunches will be provided to students with limited school cafeteria seating. Add funds to your child's PaySchools Central meal account to purchase items rather than sending cash.



Restrictions/Accommodations: CLSD will continue added safety precautions, cleaning, sanitizing, disinfecting practices, modified student lunch procedures, transportation practices, health and safety precautions, limited visitors, temperature screening.



Face Mask: Although it is highly recommended that all individuals wear masks, the Canfield Local School District is NOT requiring masks for staff and students. This may change at any time based upon information being released by the state and/or local Health Department. Masks must be worn by individuals on the bus due to federal mandates.



Quarantine: CLSD will follow the protocols of the state and/or local Health Department. If an individual is exposed to COVID in a K-12 Classroom setting and is wearing a mask or fully vaccinated, they may remain in school and participate in extracurriculars and athletics as long as they have no symptoms. However, if an individual is exposed to COVID-19 in a K-12 Classroom setting and is NOT wearing a mask or fully vaccinated, they WILL have to quarantine from school, extracurriculars, and athletics for the 10 days with an opportunity to return after 7 days pending a negative PCR test performed at least 5 days after exposure.



Parents/Guardians: Assess children daily for a temperature and symptoms. If above 100 degrees OR symptoms are present, please keep your child at home. Continue to inform the school of positive results and close contact.



Students: Upon arrival, report immediately to your classroom after temperature screening. Carry a water bottle for filling stations. Lockers/cubbies will be available for students.



Staff: Ensure all areas are cleaned and sanitized. Engage in clear communication with all stakeholders. Google Classroom/Google Meet will be used. CLSD will email a district notification of positive cases as well as keep an updated dashboard.
