All positive case information will be updated on our website under the COVID-19 Informational Dashboard. In the event of a positive case, we will email a letter to all parents in the affected building using our established all call email system and post the letter on our website. All students in the affected classroom will bring home a letter as well. If your child is identified as a close contact (within 6 feet for a cumulative 15 minutes or more), you will be called by school staff or the Health Department.
