

## Kindergarten Supply List

1. 1 book bag large enough for your child's folder (see below) to fit easily in (labeled with your child's name)
2. 1 two pocket folder\* (labeled with your child's name) (\*This folder will be kept in your child's book bag for daily work and messages from school.)
3. 1 box of Crayola brand watercolor paints 16 colors Crayola paints last longer than other types.(labeled with your child's name)
4. 1 set of headphones for use in our computer lab, in a ziplocked bagged (labeled with your child's name)
5. 1 pair of metal blade scissors Fiskar brand is recommended (labeled with your child's name)
6. 1 bottle of Elmer's white glue (labeled with your child's name)
7. 4 sharpened pencils (labeled with your child's name)
8. 1 box of 24 count crayons (labeled with your child's name)
9. 2 containers of playdough (no name needed)
10. 1 container of baby wipes wipes for messy hands (no name needed)
11. 1 pack of washable magic markers (thin or thick) (no name needed)
12. 2 Expo Markers (no name needed)
13. 2 large glue sticks (no name needed)
14. Boys: 1 pack of gallon size Ziplock baggies (no name needed)
15. Girls: 1 box of tissues
16. *Items to be kept at home* but ready for school recess on snowy days: snow boots, snow pants, mittens and a dry pair of socks for outside play

\*This is the "general kindergarten supply list". There will be additional items your child's teacher will request.

## **Kindergarten Afternoon Snack**

- Hilltop kindergarten students eat their lunch at 10:45. For this reason, the students have an afternoon snack. Each day the children are offered a variety of snacks to choose from.
- Each child is asked to bring 24 non-perishable, individually pre-packaged, snacks at the beginning of every month to share with the class.
- If your child has a food allergy on record with the school nurse, you will need to provide a personal snack box and snacks for your child. Please speak to the school nurse concerning any food allergies.

## First Grade Supply List

1. 1 box of crayons (no larger than 24)
2. 1 pair of child-sized scissors
3. 2 boxes of tissues
4. 2 JUMBO glue sticks
5. 1 large bottle of white Elmer's glue
6. 6 sharpened pencils (plain #2 sharpen the best)
7. 1 two-pocket folder (no center clasp) (STURDY PLASTIC)
8. 1 spiral notebook (single subject)
9. 4 Expo (Wipe-off) broad tip markers (BLACK only)
10. 2 broad tip highlighters (Yellow only)
11. 1 plastic storage container with no holes that measures no larger than 8 inches by 11 inches - Please make sure it is large enough to fit all school supplies, as it will be used to store supplies inside the student's desks.
12. 1 bookbag/backpack (no wheels-this is a safety concern)
13. 1 container of Clorox wipes
14. 1 set of headphones (no earbuds)

These supplies should be brought in so that your child will be prepared on the first day of school

Please label all of your child's supplies as well as their coats, hats, gloves, bookbags, etc. with their name so that we can readily match owners with their items.

During the course of the year you will want to check with your child to see if they need to replace any of their supplies. It is amazing how many crayons, pencils, glue sticks and tissue boxes we go through each semester. Thank you for your support and cooperation!
