- Parents/guardians, please continue to notify the school district within 24 hours if your child receives a positive COVID-19 test result. You have been doing an amazing job!! All positive case information will be updated on our website under the COVID-19 Informational Dashboard. In the event of a positive case, we will email a letter to all parents in the affected building using our established all call email system and post the letter on our website. All students in the affected classroom will bring home a letter. **Phone calls will continue to be made to close contact students as well.**

- In accordance with ODE's Reset & Restart Plan, we are teaming with the **Linkages Program**, under Alta Behavioral Healthcare. Linkages is a school-based training that provides suicide prevention, depression education, and optional suicide screenings. This program will be offered to all students in grades 7-12 who attend in-person and digitally. Our goal is to have all students trained in this area by 2024.

This connective activity is part of our “HEARTening” social-emotional learning focus in the school district.

- Our Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) teams will be using the **School Climate Survey** with parents/guardians, school staff, and students in grades 3-12. The survey is brief, anonymous, and completed online. **A link to the family survey will be available the week of February 1, 2021, on our district website.** All staff and students in grades 3-12 will take a survey during school. The data collected will be used to identify stakeholder perceptions in order to focus our efforts on improving our school climate as well as evaluating the effectiveness of our PBIS efforts.
- **All juniors will be taking the State-funded ACT at Canfield High School** on Tuesday, February 23, 2021, starting at 8 a.m. We will be registering students for this test. We do not register them in ACT.org

nor will we be setting up an account for them in ACT.org. Juniors should arrive at school before 7:45 a.m. as the test starts promptly at 8:00 a.m.
