- It is highly recommended that parents/guardians notify the school district within 24 hours if your child receives a positive COVID-19 test result. All positive case information will be updated on our website under the COVID-19 Informational Dashboard. In the event of a positive case, we will email a letter to all parents in the affected building using our established all call email system and post the letter on our website. All students in the affected classroom will bring home a letter as well. If your child is identified as a close contact (within 6 feet for a cumulative 15 minutes or more), you will be called by school staff or the Health Department.
- The **Emergency Remote Learning 2.0 plan** is posted on the website. Please take time to read the plan and make sure that you are prepared with childcare in the event that we will need to shift to Emergency Remote Learning for a classroom, school building, or as a district.
- **Thanksgiving Recess** begins on Wednesday, November 25, 2020. Classes will resume on Monday, November 30, 2020.
